Rangsit University Research Institute cordially invites faculty members and staff to submit research proposals for funding under the PM2.5 Research Grant Program. Interested applicants are requested to download documents (Items 1–3) from the URL: <http://rri.rsu.ac.th>, with the following details:

- 1) A memorandum for project submission – 1 copy, duly signed and approved by the Dean of the Faculty/College
- 2) A full research proposal for Rangsit University's PM2.5 Research Grant – 2 complete sets (1 original and 1 copy), duly approved and signed by the applicant's department
- 3) A copy of the proposal (Microsoft Word format) must be submitted via email to: [rsurri@rsu.ac.th](mailto:rsurri@rsu.ac.th). The hard copy proposal with all required details must also be submitted to the Research Institute from now onward.

For research projects involving human or animal experimentation, or biotechnology, researchers are required to apply for ethical clearance (human, animal, or biosafety), in parallel with the submission of the research proposal for funding. If ethical approval has already been obtained, a copy of the approval certificate must be attached with the proposal.

Please note that the Research Institute may grant research funding prior to the issuance of the ethical clearance certificate; however, the disbursement of the research grant will only be permitted once the certificate has been obtained.
